## Request for Proposals for Federal Grant Funds Fiscal Year 2019-2020

The Puerto Rico Traffic Safety Commission (PRTSC) annually receives federal funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) geared to promoting traffic safety in Puerto Rico. For the next FFY 2019-2020, the PRTSC has a work plan geared towards traffic safety initiatives focused on the prevention of car crashes and fatalities on our roadways conforming to the priority areas of: Impaired Driving, Speed, Motorcycle Safety, Distracted Driving, Non-Motorized users and broaden the Car Seat Program.

To these effects, the PRTSC is receiving proposals for grant funds focused on prevention of car crashes and fatalities on our roadways and the development and support of educational programs and applicable laws.

**All proposals must be written in English, and clearly identify the problem with good analysis, statistical data of crashes, fatalities (Years 2015-2017), surveys and any other data that evidences the problem presented. It must include the solution to the detailed problem in agreement to the proposed problem. Also, it will have to establish in a clear, measurable and quantifiable way the goals, objectives, strategies and measures of project performance; as well as the funds requested per line. The proposal must include the matching state funds sub ministered by your agency, institution or municipality for the execution of the program which should be a 20% minimum. If the proposals include salary, it must also have the job description, assignments, and equipment purchase with its justification. If it includes travel, it must be specific. Incomplete proposals will not be accepted.**

All proposals must be received on the PRTSC in its original form with a copy on or before Friday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019, also the 2018 Single Audit or a certification from an external auditor (indicating that the 2018 Single Audit is being worked on) must be included with the proposal. The approval of the submitted proposal is subject to the availability of funds and approval from NHTSA.
